

Olde America Antiques
Pillow Pattern
Decorative Pillowcase

Pre-Printed Block 6" x 9" - Finished Size 14" x 14"



This pattern is either a vertical or horizontal format.

- Creator assumes the user has basic sewing and quilting knowledge.
- All seams are 1/4 inch.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

- 1/4 Yard or Fat Quarter for Pillow Borders
- 1/8 Yard, Fat 8th or 2" Wide Strip Accent Fabric
- 1/2 Yard for Pillow Back
- 18" Square Muslin
- 16" Square Batting
- 14" Purchased Pillow Form

ADDITIONAL SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- Sewing Machine in good working order and new needle
- Rotary cutting tools, mat, ruler, cutter
- Scissors
- Straight Pins
- Sewing Machine Thread

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DIRECTIONS:

1. Carefully peel away the backing from your printed images. Trim the white border to 1/4" from the edge of the image on all 4 sides, this is your seam allowance.
2. Cut 2 rectangles 2" x 9 1/2" from accent fabric. Sew to long edges of image. Press. This creates a 9 1/2" square block for an image of vertical or horizontal orientation.
3. Cut 2 rectangles 3 1/4" x 9 1/2" from border fabric. Sew to top and bottom of image. Press.
4. Cut 2 rectangles 3 1/4" x 15" from border fabric. Sew to each side of image. Press.

PREPARE PILLOW TOP FOR QUILTING:

Sandwich muslin square as back, center batting on muslin and pieced top (squared up) and centered over batting. Pin baste. Quilt as desired. Trim quilted pillow top to 14 1/2" square.

PILLOW BACK:

1. Cut 2 rectangles 14 1/2" x 18" from backing fabric.
2. Fold each piece in half, wrong sides together, edges even to create 2 pieces 14 1/2" x 9". Overlap folded edges in center to measure 14 1/2" square. Baste overlapped edges.

Pin pillow back and quilted pillow top, right sides together. Sew around all 4 edges. Serge or zig zag raw edges. Turn right side out. Press. Stuff with 14" pillow form.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS: (as needed)

- Colorfast for hand washing:
Use cold water and mild (low PH) detergent;
an example of a low PH detergent is Ivory
- Air dry
