## Using 8" x 12" Quilt Block

### Nine-Patch Quilt Pattern

Finished Size 13" x 17" (Vert) or 17" x 13" (Horz)

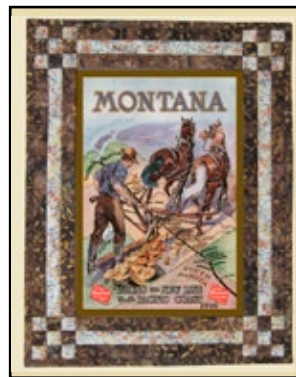
#### GENERAL INFORMATION:

- Creator assumes the user has basic sewing and quilting knowledge.
- Adjust subcut strip lengths as needed for personal measurements.
- All seams are 1/4 inch.

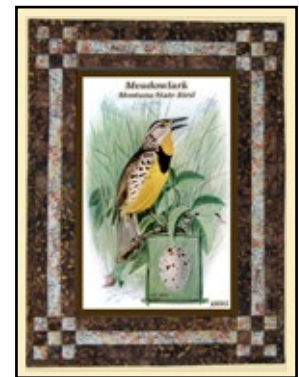
#### FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

- 1/8 Yard Light Fabric
- 1/4 Yard Dark Fabric (includes binding)
- 1/2 Yard Backing Fabric

#### ADDITIONAL SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- Sewing Machine in good working order and new needle
- Rotary cutting tools
- Mat, Ruler, Cutter, Scissors,
- Straight Pins,
- Sewing Machine Thread

#### CARE (as needed)

- Colorfast for hand washing; Use cold water and mild (neutral PH) detergent; an example of a neutral PH detergent is Ivory • Air dry
- Iron reverse side of image on low setting

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## CUTTING DIRECTIONS:

### LIGHT FABRIC:

- Cut 2 strips (selvage to selvage) 1 1/4" x 44"
- Subcut - 1 strip: 1 - 6" & 2 - 12" pieces for 9-patch corners
- Use 1 strip for full length strip set (see assembling the borders)

### DARK FABRIC:

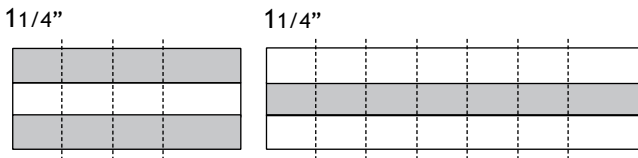
- Cut 3 strips (selvage to selvage) 1 1/4" x 44"
- Subcut - 1 strip: 2 - 6" & 1 - 12" piece for 9-patch corners
- Use 2 strips for full length strip set (see assembling the borders)
- Cut 2 strips for 65" continuous binding (strip width is personal preference)

## ASSEMBLE THE BORDERS:

- Make one full length strip set (dk-lt-dk) using 2 strips dark and one strip light. **Press to the dark fabric.**
- Cut 2 pieces 12 1/2" and 2 pieces 8 1/2".

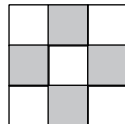
## PIECED 9-PATCH CORNERS:

- With your 6" strips of light and dark, sew one unit with dark-light-dark. With 12" strips, sew one light-dark-light as shown in Diagrams.
- Press all seams to the dark fabric.**



- From the dark-light-dark unit, cut 4 - 1 1/4" pieces across the strips as shown in diagram. Do the same with the second unit (light-dark-light) except cut 8 pieces.

- Sew your corner units (9 patches) as shown in Diagram, make 4 like this and press with iron.

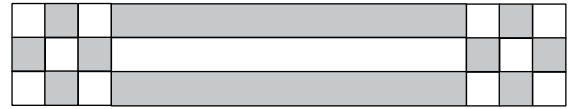


## ASSEMBLY:

- Carefully peel away the backing from your printed image. Trim the white border to 1/4" from the edge of the image on all 4 sides, this is your seam allowance.

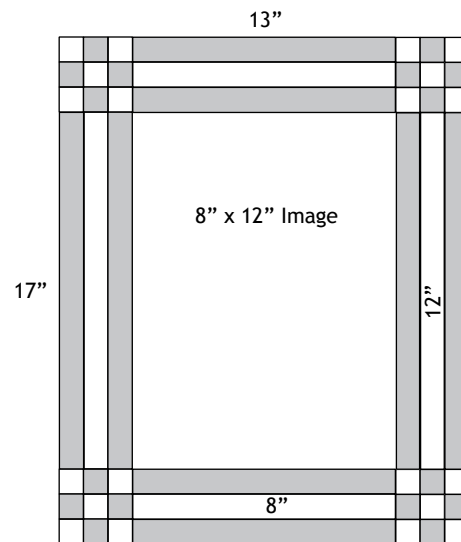
- Sew the 2 - 12 1/2" units to the long sides of the image. Press toward border.

- Sew one 9 patch corner block to each end of your 8 1/2" border units. These are your short end borders. Sew them to your wall quilt matching up the strips with the 9 patches. Press toward border.



## FINISHING YOUR WALL QUILT:

- Sandwich your quilt with your choice of batt. Either hand quilt or machine quilt it in a pleasing fashion of your choice. Bind your wall quilt and you are finished! (See Diagram)
